RESOLUTION

The 27th August, 2014

Subject: Comprehensive Guidelines relating to engagement of retired Government servants..

The engagement of retired officers is at present being governed by the guidelines issued by the Government in General Administration Department Resolution No. 19637/Gen. dated the 30th June, 1999. According to these stipulations no proposal for re-engagement of any retiring/ retired functionary shall be considered in any circumstances except in certain specified cases as laid down in the said Resolution. The situation, in the meantime has undergone a drastic change. On account of delayed recruitment for various unavoidable reasons most of the Government establishments have inordinate workload on the remaining staff. On the basis of the above consideration certain Departments of Government have obtained orders of the Government in the past to engage retired Government servants temporarily on contractual basis for different spells with different remuneration and terms and conditions on obtaining concurrence of Finance Department wherein the prescribed upper age limit for engagement was not uniform.

After careful consideration of the above situation and with a view to ensure a uniform principle it has been decided by the Government that the Departments of Government, while taking decisions for engagement of retired persons having professional excellence in Government assignments, shall follow the following principles to engage the retired Government servants on contractual basis.

1. Applicability:—

These guidelines shall apply to officers to be re-employed to such posts/services as may be decided by the Government from time to time.

2. Eligibility Conditions: —

- (i) Officers who have retired from Government service on attaining the age of superannuation and below the age of sixty five years having good service records and are physically fit shall be eligible to be considered for re-employment.
- (ii) Officers against whom departmental proceedings or criminal cases are contemplated/ pending or who have been penalized for misconduct during the period of preceding five years will not be eligible for consideration.

3. Selection Process: —

- (i) Selection of persons will be made through open advertisement.
- (ii) There shall be a Selection Committee as may be decided by the appointing authority for the post/ posts required to be filled up by re-employment.

4. Tenure, Terms and Conditions: —

- (i) The re-employment shall be made *initially for a period of two years and can be extended for subsequent period of two years with spells of one year each* subject to satisfactory performance up to a *total period of four years not beyond the age of sixty-five years* of age in any case or till the posts are filled up by regular process whichever is earlier.
- (ii) Re-employed officers will be entitled to pay and other allowances as determined by the Administrative Department/Appointing Authority with the concurrence of the Finance Department.
- (iii) Re-employed officers shall be governed by the provisions of Odisha Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1957 and shall be liable to be proceeded against for their misconduct, omissions and commissions as per the provisions under the Odisha Pension Rules, 1992.
- (iv) The re-employment can be terminated at any time by the respective appointing authority due to unsatisfactory performance of any of the re-employed officer by giving one month

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notice. On the contrary If any re-employed officer desires to resign he shall do so by giving one month's written notice to the competent authority.

5. Retention of Government Quarters: —

As provided in the Resolution No 19637/ Gen. dated the 30th June, 1999, during the period of the contract appointment the appointee may be accommodated in Government Quarters, subject to the availability, provided he pays normal rent as applicable to a Government servant occupying Government accommodation.

6. Overriding effect: —

The provisions of this resolution will supersede all previous executive instructions of the Government pertaining to re-employment of retired persons.

This Resolution shall come to force with effect from the date of publication in *Odisha Gazette*.

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Extraordinary issue of the *Odisha Gazette*. OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: - Revision of monthly consolidated remuneration on engagement of the retired Government Servant.

The fixation of re-engagement remuneration of pensioners is guided by Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 7022/F dated 17.03.2018. The revision in their monthly consolidated remuneration has been under consideration of the Government for sometimes past.

2. Now after careful consideration Government have been pleased to supersede the aforesaid F.D. Memorandum and have decided to fix the consolidated remuneration on engagement of the retired Government servants as per the prescribed remuneration structure attached to the Level in Pay Matrix in the manner as given in the following table:

2	15 & 16	Rs.46,000/-
3	11, 12, 13 & 14	Rs.35,000/-

The above remuneration on engagement of retired Government servants shall exclude pension and T.I .

✓ 3. (i) The Administrative Departments are hereby empowered to re-engage retired Government employees upto 50% of the entry level vacancies of a given cadre at their level without referring to Finance Department.

* (ii) Further prior concurrence of Finance Department shall be required in case of proposal for re-engagement of retired Government employees beyond 50% of the entry level vacancies of a given cadre. In such cases, the order of re-engagement must state the UOR/ OSWAS File No. of Finance Department in each occasion.

4. The quantum of remuneration in exceptional circumstances where Government may go for engagement of suitable retired Government servants, will be fixed by adopting the methodology of "pay minus pension". No allowances such as DA, HRA etc., shall be admissible in such cases. The tenure of such engagement and remuneration shall be determined and finalised after obtaining concurrence of Finance Department with approval of Government at the level of Hon'ble Chief Minister.

5. There may be requirement of expertise and talent of specialised nature on certain occasions for a particular purpose and specific tenure. In such exceptional cases consolidated remuneration will be fixed at a different rate than as at para-2 above, after obtaining concurrence of Finance Department with approval of Government at the level of Hon'ble Chief Minister.

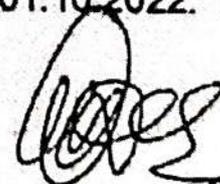
6. This Office Memorandum shall not be applicable in case of engagement of retired Government servants in any Constitutional/ Statutory posts and to any Commissions/ Boards. In such cases, the remuneration shall be fixed as per the provisions contained in their relevant rules/ guidelines.

7. The Office Memorandum is not applicable to the Allopathic Doctors and Teachers of Medical Colleges who have been engaged after their retirement.

8. Government shall reserve the right to effect any deviation, required, if any, in public interest.

9. The revision will be uniformly implemented for all existing contracts as well as new contracts.

10. This revision of consolidated monthly remuneration on engagement of retired Government servants shall come into force with effect from 01.10.2022.

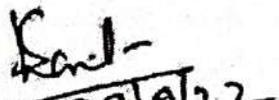

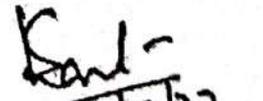

Minutes of the review meeting regarding different activities under forestry sector funded by OMBADC held on 31.01.2019 in OMBADC conference hall of Aranya Bhawan.

The list of Participants is given at Annexure-1

Initiating the discussion the CEO, CAMPA welcomed the participants and informed the purpose of the meeting i.e. review of ongoing activities and the new proposed activities to be taken up under OMBADC funding. Afforestation works through OMBADC funding have been taken up in 2016-17 and 2017-18. SMC works to the tune of Rs. 20 cr have also been undertaken in 2018. The total fund released from OMBADC for forestry activities upto 2018 is 56.06 Cr. out of which 53.11 Cr. is released to Division. The expenditure so far incurred is 49.19 Cr.

New project proposal for soil moisture conservation activities was submitted to OMBADC for approval in all 14 Division under 9 Districts. Out of that the project has been approved for taking up the work in 4 districts namely Sundargarh, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj and Jajpur under which 8 divisions are there. The funds for the SMC activities in a span of 5 years from 2018-23 has been sanctioned by OMBADC. For taking up above SMC activities the preparatory works are to be taken up by all DFOs. All the DFOs were requested to submit the action plan for the 1st year within 7 days and rest of the year within 15 days where in details of sites, which activities are to be taken up, details of works, financial outlay, maps of different layer etc. are to be submitted. They were requested to submit the detail project report immediately. The details of guidelines for the activities were given to all DFOs vide memo no. 20235 dated 03.10.2018 are revised and new guidelines are issued which are to be adhered to which should be followed strictly.

The Addl. Chief Secretary, F&E Deptt. advised all the DFOs to give more emphasis on top to bottom approach, treatment of all the channels with LBCD and concrete structure where ever necessary and construction of graded guided earthen bund along the periphery of all forest blocks. He also emphasized on Involvement of the VSS member in all activities. Proper signage should be given in all location. The signage will have following contents and uniform colour in all division.

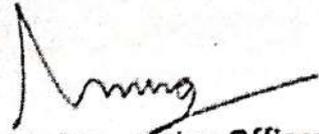
- Logo of OMBADC

One OMBADC cell is to be created in each Division with engagement of 2 nos of retired forest and engineering personnel who will maintain and supervise the activities and take up active role in plan preparation and documentation also.

All DFOs were requested to submit them up-to-date accounts immediately.

The details of new accounting procedure regarding fund flow and utilization were appraised to all DFOs. They were further requested to go through the letter no. 34954 dated 06.11.2018 of Finance deptt. In the matter and contact the concern treasury officer of their jurisdiction to open PL operator ID and creation of necessary deposit balance in works module for "Deposit Works".

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.

Revised Guideline for Implementation of projects for SMC measures under OMBADC Funding.

Ref: This office memo No. 16370 dt.30.07.2018, Memo No.18410 dt. 01.09.2018 and Memo No 20235 dt.03.10.2018.

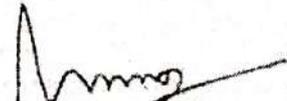
As you are aware, SMC measures will be taken up in forest areas of your divisions under OMBADC funding, as per review meeting held on 31.01.2019 in the OMBADC Conference Hall of Aranya Bhawan (copy of which is enclosed herewith). The year wise details of the activities to be taken up has already been communicated to you vide memo under reference. The funds for the purpose may be received shortly from OMBADC. The matter was also discussed in the video conference held on dt.07.09.2018. The above projects need to be implemented very scrupulously for its success and the following guideline is to be followed while implementing the same.

1. The detailed Annual Action Plan for the purpose need to be prepared taking into account all the parameters. The Action Plan for 2018-19 must be submitted by dt.15.02.2019 and the Action Plan for subsequent years may be submitted in another one month time.
2. Before implementing the project, the meeting of the local VSS should be taken up and they should be informed in detail regarding the activities to be undertaken. The site inspection may also be taken up with the members of the VSS while implementing the project and they may be enlightened regarding the impact of the project and fully involved in execution of the project.
3. An OMBADC Cell should be opened in each implementing divisions which will assist in monitoring and execution of all the works funded by OMBADC. In each cell Two retired forest personnel should be engaged through service provider. Those personnel should have ample

knowledge regarding execution of SMC measures and plantation activities. They should be responsible for Monitoring, Reporting, Preparation of Plan, Documentation, Training etc. payment to PMU staff will be given out of contingency fund of OMBADC.

4. Proper documentation of the activities along with the condition of the forests before and after taking up of the project needs to be done.
5. Proper signage should be prepared in all the sites wherever the activities are being taken up showing the details of work, year of operation, funding agency, Implementing agency, and cost of the projects etc. with OMBADC Logo.
6. Proper monitoring of the works need to be taken up at different level so that, the project can be implemented successfully.
7. Social audit of the project has to be taken up by involving the VSS/Gram Sabha so that, transparency is maintained.
8. Internal evaluation of the impact of the project in the locality should be taken up and if possible evaluation by third party may also be taken up.

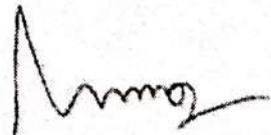

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

1. Fixation of consolidated remuneration on engagement of the retired Government Servant.

The fixation of re-employment pay of pensioners is guided by Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 5554/F., dated 16.02.2012 and Guidelines relating to re-employment of contractual basis with consolidated remuneration is guided by Finance Department Office Memorandum No. 8852/F., dated 12.03.2012.

2. Now after careful consideration Government have been pleased to supersede the aforesaid Memoranda and have decided to fix the consolidated remuneration on engagement of the retired Government servants in the following manner.

3. On engagement, the retired Government servant will avail remuneration only in consolidated manner as per prescribed remuneration structure attached to the Level in the Pay Matrix as given in table below:

Sl. No.	Levels under ORSP Rules, 2017	Consolidated Remuneration (per month)
(1)	(2)	(3)
1	15,16 & 17	Rs.42,000/-
2	11,12,13 & 14	Rs.30,000/-
3	5,6,7,8,9 & 10	Rs. 13,000/-
4	1,2,3 & 4	Rs. 6,500/-

The above remuneration on engagement of retired Government servants is excluding the Pension and T.I. which he/she avails.

4. There may be requirement of expertise and talent of specialised nature certain occasion for a particular purpose and specific tenure. The Government in such exceptional circumstances may go for engagement of suitable retired Government Servants. In such exceptional cases, the quantum of the remuneration may be decided on a different principle. The terms of engagement and the remuneration in such exceptional cases will be determined and finalised only on prior concurrence of the Finance Department.

5. Prior concurrence of Finance Department in all cases will be obtained before any engagement and in subsequent engagement order is issued. The order must state the UOR No. of the Finance Department in each occasion.

The Office Memorandum is not applicable to the Allopathic Doctors & Teachers who have been engaged after their retirement as separate orders to be issued by the H & F.W. Department after concurrence with Finance Department. It will also not apply to the engagement of retired Government servants in the constitutional/ statutory post and to any Commission as ordered by Government from time to time.

The Fixation of remuneration on engagement of retired Government servants shall come into force with effect from 01.10.2017. Re-employment pay/ remuneration fixed earlier shall accordingly be revised as per this Office Memorandum.
