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SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR BIDDERS

1. The Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh requires the services of reputed, well established and financially sound Service Providers to provide

(I) Services of Watchmen-cum-Sweeper personnel (One Number) for Watchmen-cum-Sweeper of CT & GST Circle, Deogarh Building.

(II) Sweeping & cleaning the CT & GST Circle Building and its surrounding toilets and bathrooms, daily drain and pipe lines when choked, cleaning of IT equipment's, glass doors & windows, railing staircase, elevator room and wild grass from the pathway around the building by uprooting)

2. The contract for providing the aforesaid Services is likely to come w.e.f 01.12.2024 and would continue till 30.11.2026 on satisfactory performance. However, the service contract may be terminated at any time owing to a deficiency in service or substandard quality of service by the selected Service Provider or because of a change in the requirements of the Department. The Department, however, reserves the right to terminate this initial contract at any time after giving one month's notice to the selected Service Provider.

3. The aforesaid requirement is tentative which may increase or decrease basing on the requirement of the Department. The final requirement will be as per the agreement entered into with the selected bidder.

4. The interested Service Providers may submit the Tender document complete in all respects and other requisite documents by 11.11.2024 upto 5.00 P.M by postal or courier service to the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh, PIN- 768108.

5. The various crucial dates relating to Tender for Providing 1 no. of Watchmen-cum-Sweeper Personnel for O/o the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh for Sweeping and its surrounding, all the chambers, halls, toilets and bathrooms, daily drain and pipe lines when choked, cleaning of LT equipment's, glass doors & windows, staircase railing, elevator room and wild grass from the pathway around the building by uprooting).

6. The tender has been invited under two bid systems i.e. Technical Bid and Financial Bid. The interested agencies are advised to submit two separate sealed envelopes superscribing "Technical Bid & Financial Bid for Providing Watchmen-cum-Sweeper Personnel" to the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh. Both sealed envelopes should be kept in a third sealed envelope.



7. The Earnest Money Deposit (EMD): Exempted from submission of EMD. Bid Security Declaration should be submitted in lieu of EMD as per O.M No 8943/F dated 18.03.2021 of Finance Department, Govt. of Odisha.

8. The successful bidder will have to deposit a Performance Security Deposit of 3% of the value of his bided contract (as per Govt. in FD Memorandum No. 290 dated 05.01.2022) in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank drawn in favor of the "Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT& GST Circle, Deogarh", covering the contract period. In case, the contract is further extended beyond the initial period, the Guarantee Bank will have to be renewed accordingly by the successful bidder.

09. The Security Deposit shall be forfeited, if the successful bidder fails to undertake the work or fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions of the contract.

10. The tendering Service providers are required to enclose photocopies of the following documents (self-attested), along with the Technical Bid, failing which their bids shall be summarily / out rightly rejected and shall not be considered any further:

(l) Aadhar card of the Proprietor/ Partner/ Directors of the said company.

The conditional bids shall not be considered and will be out rightly rejected in the very first instance.

11. All entries in the tender form should be legible and filled clearly. If the space for furnishing information is insufficient, a separate sheet duly signed by the authorized signatory may be attached. No overwriting or cutting is permitted in the Financial Bid Form. In such cases, the tender shall be summarily rejected. However, the cuttings, if any, in the Technical Bid Application must be initialed by the person authorized to sign the tender bids.

12. The Technical bids shall be opened on the scheduled date and time at 11.00 A.M on 12.11.2024 in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh. The Financial bids shall be opened at 12.00 P.M. on 12.11.2024 in the office of the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh in the presence of the representatives of the Service Providers, if any, who wishes to be present at the spot at that time.

13. The Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh reserves the right to annual all bids without assigning any reason.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TENDERING MANPOWER SERVICE PROVIDER

1. The tendering Security service provider should fulfill the following technical specifications

(a) The registered office or one of the branch offices of the Service provider should be located at Deogarh.

(b) They should be registered with the appropriate registering authority.

(c) They should have at least two year's experience in providing Ward & Watch to Government Departments, Public Sector Companies / Banks, etc.;

(d) They should have their own Bank Account

(e) They should be registered with the Income Tax and Service Tax/CT & GST Departments of either Central or State Government.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

GENERAL

1. The Agreement shall commence from 01.12.2024 and shall continue till 30.11.2026 unless it is curtailed or terminated by the authority owing to deficiency of service, sub - standard quality of deployed personnel, breach of contract etc. or change in requirements.
2. The Agreement shall automatically expire on 30.11.2026 unless extended further by the Authority.
3. The Agreement may be extended, on the same terms and conditions or with some additions/ deletions / modifications, for a further specific period by the Authority.
4. The Service Provider shall not be allowed to transfer, assign, pledge or subcontract its rights and liabilities under this Agreement to any other agency or organization by whatever name be called without the prior written consent of the Authority.
5. The Department at present, has tentative requirement of watch & ward personnel. The requirement of the Department may further increase or decrease marginally, during the period of initial contract also and the tenderer would have to provide additional personnel, if required, on the same terms and conditions.
6. The Service Provider shall be bound by the details furnished by it to the Authority while submitting the tender or at a subsequent stage. In any case, any such document furnished by it, is found to be false at any stage, it would be deemed to be a breach of the terms of the Agreement making it liable for legal action other than termination of the Agreement.
7. The Persons deployed on security duty shall be required to perform duty from 5.30 PM to 10 AM all days including holidays Office of the Authority. The Service Provider shall arrange to maintain attendance record of the Watchmen-cum-Sweeper personnel deployed by to indicate their arrival and departure time. The photocopy of the attendance record shall be submitted at the time of submission of the monthly bill in the office of the Authority.
8. The service provider should carry out the work in Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, CT & GST Circle, Deogarh as per the following schedule:
 - a. The Watchmen-cum-Sweeper personnel should leave the premises after 10.00 A.M with intimation to the in-charge officer.
 - b. The Watchmen-cum-Sweeper personnel engaged by the Service Provider shall wear the uniform, which will be finalized in consultation with the Authority.
 - c. The service provider shall bear a photo ID card issued by the service provider during the period of work.
 - d. The Watchmen-cum-Sweeper personnel power to be engaged by the service provider should be covered under the statutory Government regulation framed from time to time.



- e. Any damage / pilferage to Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST Circle, Deogarh Property due to mishandling and carelessness of the service provider or his workmen will be recoverable from the service provider's bill.
- f. The service provider should depute a qualified and dedicated person to supervise the work as undertaken.
- g. The Watch & Wards personnel deployed by the service provider shall be required to attend the office on any holidays and Sundays.
9. The Service Providing Agency shall be required to deploy 01 sweeping and cleaning personnel with supervisor for the purpose of sweeping and cleaning and will do the work as specified below
- a. All toilets, urinal pans, wash basins are to be cleaned and sanitized by using "Harpic" twice a day.
- b. Walls, roofs, glass partitions, glass windows, fans, pipes, mirrors, tables, chairs, Almirahs and all other office belongings are to be cleaned & maintained dust free by using proper cleaning materials. Computers, printers, monitors, servers and other IT hardware's are to be cleaned daily and safely by "Colin" once a week i.e. on the 1st working day of the week. The web cob etc. from the roofs and walls must be cleaned once in a month which includes out the surface of the rooms. The tree growing on the buildings are to be uprooted once in every two months.
- c. The toilets should be maintained extremely sanitized every day, so that there should not be any foul smell coming from this.
- d. The lift, staircase & stair case railings shall be cleaned up every day neatly.
- e. Bleaching powder should be sprinkled in open drain once a week.
- f. Ground floor and open floors should be cleaned with liquid soap / detergent powder once a week.
- g. Sweeping of the campus office should be completed before 9:00 A.M.
- h. Sweeping and cleaning of the floor of the office building to be completed before 09.00 A.M.
- i. Sweeping and cleaning of toilets and bathrooms twice a day to be completed before 9.30 A.M, 6.00 P.M.
- j. Cleaning of daily drain and cleaning of pipe lines as and when choked.
- k. The wild grass from the pathways around the building should also be cleaned by way of uprooting once in a month.
- l. Cleaning of Toilets, Urinals etc.
- m. All the materials for cleaning will be provided by the office.

10. The Watch & Ward personnel deployed by the service provider shall be required to report for work at 10.00 A.M to the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, Deogarh (O.E.) or such other officer as may have been kept in charge of the Establishment Office of the Deputy Commissioner of CT& GST, Deogarh, and would leave at 5.30 P.M. and may also be required to work beyond 5.30 P.M for which they will not be paid any extra remuneration. In this case, the deployed person remains absent on a particular day or comes late / leaves early on three occasions, proportionate deduction from the remuneration for one day will be made. The Housekeeping personnel deployed by the service provider shall work throughout the month in maintaining the rooms of the officers/ staff (except on all Sundays of each month)

11. The entire financial liability in respect of the personnel deployed in the Department or Office concerned shall be that of the Service Provider and the Department or Office concerned will in no way be liable. It shall be mandatory for the service provider to pay monthly remuneration to the persons deployed through their bank accounts by the seventh day of the succeeding month, and produce necessary evidence by 10th day of the succeeding month for sanction of monthly payment by this office. The service provider shall ensure that the persons deployed by him are paid their monthly remuneration on monthly basis, by the due date, irrespective of whether he has received payment from this organization or not.

12. For all intents and purposes, the Service Provider shall be the "Employer" within the meaning of different Rules & Acts in respect of personnel so deployed. There shall not be any "employee and employer" relationship between the persons deployed by the service provider and this organization.

13. The Service Provider shall be solely responsible for the redressal of grievances or resolution of disputes relating to deployed persons. The Department shall, in no way, be liable for the settlement of such issues whatsoever.

14. The Department shall not be liable for any financial loss or any injury to the person deployed by the Service Provider in the course of their performing the functions / duties, or for payment towards any compensation.

15. Persons deployed by the Service Provider shall not claim nor be entitled to pay, perks and other facilities admissible to regular / confirmed employees during the currency or after the expiry of the Agreement.

16. In the case of termination of this Agreement on its expiry or otherwise, the persons deployed by the Service Provider shall not be entitled to and shall have no claim for any absorption in regular or other capacity.

17. The persons deployed shall not claim any benefit or compensation or absorption or regularization of deployment with the office under the provision of rules and Acts. Undertaking from the person deployed to this effect shall be required to be submitted by the Service Provider.

18. The Service Provider must be registered with the concerned Govt. Authorities, i.e. Labor Commissioner, Provident Fund Authorities, Employees State Insurance Corporation etc. and a copy of the registration should be submitted. The Service Provider shall comply

with all the legal requirements for obtaining a License under the Labor Contract (Regulations and Abolition) Act, 1970 if any, at its own part and cost.

19. The Service Provider shall provide a substitute well in advance if there occurs any probability of the person leaving the job due to his / her own personal reasons. The payment in respect of the overlapping period of the substitute shall be the responsibility of the Manpower Service Provider. The Service Provider shall be responsible for contributions towards the Provident Fund and Employees State Insurance, wherever applicable.

20. The persons deployed by the Service Provider should not have any criminal records.

21. The persons deployed should be polite, cordial and efficient while handling the assigned work and their actions should promote good will and enhance the image of the Department or office concerned. The Service Provider shall be responsible for any Act on indiscipline on the part of the deployed.

LEGAL:

22. The person deployed shall, during the course of their work be privy to certain qualified documents and information which they are not supposed to divulge to third parties. In view of this, they shall be required to take oath of confidentiality and breach of this condition shall make the Service Provider as well as the person deployed liable for penal action under the applicable laws besides, action for breach of contract,

23. The Service provider shall be responsible for compliance with all statutory provisions relating to minimum wages payable to different types of workers in respect of the persons deployed by it in the Department or office concerned. The Department or office concerned shall have no liability in this regard.

24. The Service Provider shall also be liable for depositing all taxes, levies, Cess etc. on account of service rendered by it to the concerned Department or office concerned to the concerned tax collection authorities, from time to time, as per the rules and regulations in the matter. Attested photocopies of such documents shall be furnished to the Department or office concerned.

25. The Service Provider shall maintain all statutory registers under the Law and shall produce the same, on demand, to the authority of the Department or office concerned or any other authority under the Law.

26. The Tax deduction at Source (T.D.S.) shall be done as per the provisions of the Income Tax Act / Rules, as amended, from time to time by the Service Provider and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the Department or office concerned.

27. In this case, the Service Provider fails to comply with any liability under appropriate law, and as a result thereof, the Department or the concerned office is put to any loss obligation, monetary or otherwise, the Department or the concerned office shall be entitled to get itself reimbursed out of the outstanding bills or the Performance Security Deposit of the Service Provider, to the extent of the loss or obligation in monetary terms.

28. The Agreement is liable to be terminated because of non-performance, deviation of terms and conditions of contract, non - payment of remuneration of employed persons and



non - payment of statutory dues. The concerned Department or Office shall have no liability towards non - payment of remuneration to the persons employed by the Service Provider and the outstanding statutory dues of the service provider to the statutory authorities. If any loss or damage is caused to the Department or Office concerned by the deployed persons, the same shall be recovered from the unpaid bills or adjusted from the Performance Security Deposit.

FINANCIAL:

29. The Technical Bid are exempted from submission of EMD as per O.M No 8943/F dated 18.03.2021 & OM No 281 dated 05.01.2022 of Govt. in Finance Department.

30. However, a Bid Security Declaration should be submitted in lieu of EMD as per O.M No 8943/F dated 18.03.2021 of Finance Department, Government of Odisha.

31. The successful bidder will have to deposit Performance Security Deposit equal to 3% of the Annual Contract value (as per OM No 290 dated 05.01.2022 of Finance Department, Govt. of Odisha) in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank drawn favor of the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Odisha, Cuttack covering the period of the contract. In case, the contract is further extended beyond the initial period, the Guarantee Bank will have to be renewed accordingly by the successful bidder.

32. In the event of breach of any terms and conditions attached to this agreement, the Agreement shall be annulled.

33. The Service Provider, after making payment of the monthly remuneration to the persons deployed, shall raise the bill, in triplicate, along with attendance sheet duly verified by the Officer concerned and proof of payment of monthly remuneration and submit the same to the Deputy Commissioner of CT & GST, Deogarh Circle, Deogarh by the 10th day of the succeeding month and the payment to the service provider will be released by this organization within 15 days thereafter.

34. Irrespective of the date of submission of the bill by the service provider and irrespective of the date of payment made by this organization to the service provider, the service provider shall pay monthly remuneration to the persons deployed by him positively by 7th of the succeeding month, and also through their bank accounts.

35. The claims in bills regarding Employees State Insurance, Provident Fund, and Service Tax etc. should be accompanied by documentary proof pertaining to the relevant bill month. A requisite portion of the bill or the whole of the bill amount shall be held up until such proof is furnished, at the discretion of the Department or Office concerned.

36. In case of any change in Statutory minimum Wages. Labour welfare measures or taxes/cess during the contract period, made by competent Government Authorities. This contract between the service provider and this organization shall stand modified accordingly with immediate effect.

37. The Authority reserves the right to withdraw or relax any of the terms and conditions mentioned above.

38. All disputes shall be under the jurisdiction of the court at the place where the headquarters of the authority, who has executed the agreement, is located.

39. The successful bidder shall enter into an agreement with this Department for the supply of suitable and qualified personnel as per the requirement of this Department on the above terms and conditions.


